Extension: Network

This extension might be a bit of a Work In Progress.

At this time you can check for network connectivity, get the IP address of the client and the location.

The data is returned as a list so it can be that future features will make the list longer!



This block will let you know if the device has a connection to the internet. It will not actually connect to the internet when you use this block but it will reflect the status after you used this block:



In the URL you put a web-address. When you don't have your own server use the address noted in the example.

The Extra text field is used to supply data to the network script. The only word that currently works is the text: loc

This will return the location of the device.

The default is that this loc information is not supplied since it will make another web-call and makes the action slower. So if you don't need the location leave the Extra field blank.

This request block is the only thing that actually makes a connection to the server so please use sparsely!



With this block you get the data back from the server. Currently it is in this order:

- IP address
- Browser/package that connects to the server
- Location when asked with loc

As told maybe later more data is returned in this list when adjustments are made on the server.



This data is calculated each time the request data is used. Return value is in milliseconds.
